





Updated Login window for Kurzweil 3000 for Mac (Web License Subscription Only).

Filter Universal Library folders by name in Kurzweil 3000 for Windows.

In large subscriptions, it can be time consuming to find a particular user's folder. For subscriptions with over 1,000 licenses, you can search the top level list of user folders by last name to quickly locate a student or teacher folder.

In smaller subscriptions of less than 1,000 licenses, the field filters by folder name.

- Go to the Universal Library to Open or Save a file
- Start typing the filter criteria in the Filter folders by last name or Filter folders by name field.
- The list of folders will be filtered by that criteria.



Move a File


Drag and drop the file from one folder to another.



Copy a File


- In a Windows internet browser, press and hold the Ctrl key on the keyboard while you drag and drop your file.
- In a *Mac internet browser*, press and hold the **Option key** on the keyboard while you drag and drop your file.

Note: Remember to *let go of the mouse button first*, before the keyboard button when copying.



Add an Image Caption to a Bubble Note in Kurzweil 3000 for Web Browsers (Kurzweil3000.com).

When adding an image to a bubble note, add a text caption in the Image Caption field. The text will read when the bubble note is read, but will not show on the screen.





Menu and button changes in Kurzweil 3000 for Web Browsers (Kurzweil3000.com).


Buttons have been added to the Highlighter, Notes and Tools menus, and the Column Notes button has been added to the top toolbar (see item 8).

New Menu




Old Menu







Note: These buttons were removed from the top toolbar.




Re-Recognize Page and resolve Underlying Text Conflicts in Kurzweil 3000 for Web Browsers (Kurzweil3000.com).

Occasionally you need to re-recognize a page in a document. This is like rescanning the page with the OCR engine. It will remove any zone changes you have made and look for any conflicts with the existing underlying text.

- Go to the page you want to re-recognize
- Choose Tools menu > Zone Edit....
- Click the Re-Recognize tab and click the Re-Recognize Page button.


A prompt will remind you that any zone edits will be lost. Click Yes to re-recognize the page.

Any previous changes to the Underlying Text that conflict with the newly recognized text, will appear in the **Underlying Text Conflict window.**

Use Original - the underlying text that was present before the re-recognize.


Use New - the underlying text as the re-recognize sees it. **Use Other** - enter your own word to be read.

Restore All Original Words - keep all underlying text as it was before the re-recognize.

Keep All New Words - keep all underlying text as the re-recognize sees them.

The option to Save will appear when all word conflicts are resolved.



If you have text overriding a zone, you can edit that text while in the Edit Underlying Text window.


Open Column Notes

Open an existing notes file from your Universal Library.

Column notes have a .k3c file extension.


Type directly into the notes, or drag and drop text **from a text or image document** into the column notes. You can also drag and drop text from the column notes **into a writing document**. Note: In IE or Edge, hold the Ctrl key to copy to/from column notes.

Extract Highlights to Column Notes

Highlight your document with different highlighters and extract them into a column notes file.






Extract Column Notes to Outline

If you have a writing assignment based on the reading you can then extract those notes into an Outline file to start writing.

Extract Highlights to Vocabulary Study Guide

Highlight specific words in your document and extract them into a study guide. Definitions will automatically appear in the Definition 1 & 2 columns.



Customize Highlighter/Extract Options

The options for customizing how highlights are extracted has been updated to include options for column notes.






