Web subscription - Read the Web browser extension - Log in Remember Me



In Chrome, Bing and/or Firefox, store your login credentials in the browser for Auto Log In when logging in manually, or when using a Google or Microsoft account.



- 1. Click the "Remember Me" button Remember Me
- 2. Enter your username and password or log in using the Google or Microsoft button.
- 3. After, the extension times out or the browser is closed and
 - a. returning to the same browser, the extension will automatically load and sign in.

Chromebook - Read the Web browser extension - Shortcut keys



When using the Read the Web browser extension on a Chromebook, shortcut keys now work for:

- Read/Pause (Alt + P)
- Back one unit (Alt + ,) (left arrow key)
- Forward one unit (Alt + .) (right arrow key)
