



Install Guide – Kurzweil 3000 Read the Web for Mozilla Firefox (Windows)

Last Updated: April 2015

Follow the instructions below to install the Kurzweil 3000 (K3000) Read the Web add-on in the Mozilla Firefox web browser.

Although there are many steps listed below, the Read the Web add-on install process is not complicated. (1) First make sure Firefox is installed on the computer. (2) Then click the Read the Web button in Kurzweil 3000 and follow the prompts. This document is authored for those that may have difficulties following the prompts.

Tech Info: This installation process should be conducted on each computer and once per user that logs into that computer. However, if your organization has roaming profiles enabled for Windows domain users, this process should only need to be followed once per domain user, installing the add-on to that user's roaming Firefox profile.

Preparation Step:

First, make sure the Firefox web browser is installed on the computer.

If it is a personal computer that you have administrative access to, you can download and install Firefox from here: <https://www.mozilla.org/>

If you are in a school environment, where you have limited access to computers, please contact your IT dept. and have a technician install Firefox on select computers.




Optional Step:

Only conduct this step if Internet Explorer is launched instead of Firefox when you click the **Read the Web** button in the K3000 menu toolbar.

Make sure that K3000 is set to use Mozilla Firefox as its Read the Web browser.

In the K3000 menu, go to **Tools > Options... > Reading**

In the Read the Web section of the window, make sure the radio button for **Mozilla Firefox** is selected. Then click **OK**.




1. Click the **Read the Web** button




in the K3000 toolbar.

Alternatively, in the K3000 menu you can go to **Read > Read the Web**.

If the Read the Web add-on isn't already installed in Firefox, you will receive the prompts listed in the steps below.




2. Click the **Yes** button.




3. Click the **OK** button.

Firefox should be in a separate window.



3. In the new Firefox window, you will receive a Software Installation prompt that may include a warning about installing add-ons.

In the **Software Installation** window within Firefox, click the **Install Now** button.



4. A small pop-up window at the top-left corner of Firefox may appear, prompting you to restart Firefox.

Click the **Restart Now** button. If you do not receive this prompt, then close Firefox.

5. Make sure that all Firefox windows are closed and Firefox is no longer running.


6. Click back over to K3000. In the K3000 toolbar, click the **Read the Web**




button one more time.

Alternatively, in the K3000 menu you can go to **Read > Read the Web**.

This will launch Firefox one more time.



7. In the open Firefox window, at the top, you should see a new Kurzweil Read the Web toolbar with a **Previous**, **Read/Pause**, and **Next** button.



8. You can now read selectable text on web pages by highlighting text and clicking the **Read/Pause** button.

In the picture to the right the words **Get to Google faster. Switch** is highlighted.
